

Dear **Applied Topology** in Bedlewo Participants,

We want to share with you a few updates regarding the conference:

1) At the [webpage](#) you can find the schedule of talks. During this conference we are planning three types of talks - plenary (55 min), middle (40 min) and short ones (25 min).

Such a split into talks of distinct length and parallel sessions was necessary to "pack" all the lectures in short time of the meeting. The plenary lectures will be given by the representatives of mainstream topics of the conference. This forced time restriction for the remaining speakers. We hope that you understand the situation.

All the classrooms are equipped with projector and blackboard. Note for all the participants who are to give a talk in the lecture room C -- due to the shape of the lecture room C and projection on the screen we strongly recommend to use computer presentations for all the lectures there.

2) On Sunday, 21.07 there are three introductory lectures to the topic of the conference. Following a condition required by the sponsoring institutions all the grad students who obtain the support for the conference are obliged to report of their presence on the lectures. We strongly encourage any other participants to join us.

3) We have preliminary bus schedule based on the participants who inform us about their time of arrival. Right now we would like to fix the list of participants who want to take a ride on Sunday 21.07. We will deal with the transportation on Saturday 27 during the conference. At the front mirror of all the buses there will be a note "Conference Bedlewo". At the railway station the bus will be most likely under the bridge (once you are there, you cannot miss it). We are planning to send 4 buses in Sunday:

3a) 10:10 (Railway station), 10:40 (Railway station) - scheduled passengers (Iriye, Silva, Scoville)

3b) 13:10 (Railway station) and 13:40 (airport) - scheduled passengers (Kukiela, Błaszczuk, Adams, Robinson, Belchí, Adiprasito, Farber, Intermont, Firsching, Franc, Colman, Ortega, Maro, Grant, Kaji)

(NOTE - this is the last bus which should be in Bedlewo slightly before the first lecture).

3c) 16:30 (airport), 17:00 (railway station) - scheduled passengers (Kishimoto, Jojic, Volovikov, Fajstrup, Shchepin, Karasev, Graff, Costa, Weilandt, Ferrario)

3d) 19:30 (Airport), 20:30 (Railway station) - scheduled passengers (Vrecica, Choi, Wang, Bubenik, Kurlin, Gulgowski, Han, Wagner)

If you are already listed as passenger, you do not need to do anything. But if you are not listed, please use the webpages below to enlist for the bus you want to take. If you do not do it, we may have no place for you in the bus. If you are traveling with your spouse, please list her/him as well. It is possible to arrange another bus if necessary.

We use the format: "Name, Family name, pickup location", where pickup location \in \{airport, railway station\}. For instance "Pawel Dlotko (airport)".

In case of any problems please find the instructions how to get to Bedlewo on your own in below:

By car to Będlewo:

If you wish to come to Będlewo by car, you have to enter the national route number 5 (European route number E261) Poznań - Wrocław. When coming from the north (Poznań), 6 km after Stęszew (31 km from Poznań) turn left to route 309 towards Mosina. The Będlewo conference center is about 3 km from the crossing at the end of Będlewo village on your left. When coming from the South (Wrocław), 6 km after Gluchowo (21 km from Kościan, 151 km from Wrocław) turn right to route 309 towards Mosina. Again, the Będlewo conference center is about 3 km from the crossing at the end of Będlewo village on your left.

From the Poznań airport to Będlewo

From the Poznań Ławica Airport take a taxi to the main railway station in Poznań (Poznań Główny). The fare from the airport is about 50 PLN (13 EUR) on Sundays and nights and half of that on weekdays. Just to be on a safe side - please ask for the estimated price before taking it. There is also a city bus line No 59 to the centre of Poznań, but its last stop (Rondo Kaponiera) is about 700 m away from the railway Station. There is also a bus (line L) which goes directly to the railway station with no stops. The schedule can be find [here](#). Tickets can be found in machine out of the Lawica airport.

Once you reach Poznań main railway station, follow the directions below.

From the Poznań main railway station to Będlewo Buy a ticket for a local train from Poznań to Mosina. From the Mosina train station take a taxi to the Conference Center in Będlewo (approx. 9 km, the fare is 40-50 PLN).
