announces an open call
for a 5-years research position in the Warsaw Branch

The Institute offers a research position starting October 1, 2018 in biomathematics, in particular in bioinformatics and computational biology.

Candidates are required to hold a PhD degree in mathematical sciences or related fields, obtained not earlier than in 2007.

It is expected that the person employed will create his or her own research team at IM PAN, in cooperation with other research units, in particular with the International Institute of Molecular and Cell Biology (IIMCB) in Warsaw and the Faculty of Mathematics, Computer Science and Mechanics of the University of Warsaw (MIMUW). The Institute expects that the candidate will participate in national and international research programmes and grants, and will apply for such grants. The Institute will support such activities.

The achievements of the person employed within this competition shall be subject to periodic review.

The application together with the description of research and organisational programme, CV, list of publications and consent for the processing of personal data for the purposes of the recruitment process, should be sent not later than on January 23, 2018 to the address:
